

NYC Local Law 84:


- ullet starting August 2011, applies to commercial buildings > 50,000 gsf
- owners upload energy information to benchmarking tools
- public disclosure of:
 - energy & water use, total and psf
 - ratings / comparison to other buildings
 - ratings / comparison over time

Information is expected to affect:



- tenants








































Peer Comparisons

Peer groups for buildings are usually established by:


- energy system


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
Anomaly Detection in Time Series

Operator error is a frequent source of lost energy; weather normalization can detect and alert us to pattern differences.




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
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

Research Design & Questions
